Rules and Regulations of Post-Graduate teachers in the University

[Revised in Compliance of the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedures for the Award of MPhil/PhD Degree) Regulation, 2016 as notified in The Gazette of India (No.278, Part III – Section 4) 5 July 2016.]

R.PGR.1 For Master's Degree:

- (a) Full time teachers (with qualifications prescribed by the UGC from time to time) appointed in under-graduate colleges or persons employed in recognized institutions with Ph.D. degree/NET/GSLET are automatically recognized as P.G. teachers for Master degree in relevant subject.
- (b) Full time teachers as above without Ph.D. to be recognized for a post-graduate teaching work should have the three years experience of under graduate teaching or two years P.G. experience else where. The teacher having M.Phil degree may be given a relaxation in experience of one year.
- (c) The Teacher will have to make a formal application to seek such recognition.

Moreover, the existing rules for recognition as post-graduate teacher for Master degree the made applicable for recognition as Post-Graduate teacher for Master's degree in Industrial Chemistry as well as other such disciplines and the teaching experience of Post B.Sc. Diploma be also considered in place of Bachelor's degree examination wherever necessary.
