Guidelines for Paper Submission

- The paper should be based on one the themes mentioned above. Clearly mention the theme chosen by you.
- The title should be concise and clearly reflect the content of the paper. Include an abstract of 150-200 words summarizing the main focus of the paper. Use a consistent citation style (APA-7 style) for all references. Include a cover page with the paper title, theme, author(s) name(s), affiliation(s), and contact information.
- Language of the paper can be Gujarati/ Hindi/ English. Papers should be between 3000-5000 words.
- Use Times New Roman (Size 12) for English version. For Gujarati and Hindi versions, use Unicode.
- Submit papers in PDF and Microsoft Word format on this email id seminar.edu.spuvvn@gmail.com
 by September 28, 2024. Name the file as "AuthorLastName_FirstName.pdf/docx". Late submissions will not be accepted.
- Each presenter will have 10 minutes for presentation followed by a 5-minute Q&A session.
- Papers must be original work and not published or submitted elsewhere. Plagiarism in any form will
 result in disqualification.
- Certificate of Participation/Paper Presentation will be issued only to those who attend the seminar (Offline/Online) thoroughly. Online Presenters will be provided E-Certificates.
- Authors and Co-authors have to register and pay the fees separately.

Selected papers will be published in ISBN Book of National Level. Process for the same will be intimated later on.
